



STAINED GLASS WINDOW DESIGN COMPETITION

Competition Terms and Conditions

1. This competition is open to entrants of all ages.
2. It is a condition of entry that these terms and conditions are accepted as final and that the entrant agrees to abide by them. Submission of an entry will be taken to mean acceptance of these terms and conditions.
3. To enter this competition, entrants must submit their design or drawing on A4 paper, along with an explanation of the inspiration for their design. Entrants must include their name, address and contact telephone number on the reverse of each entry and must complete the Entry Form. The written element of an entry must be in English and be no more than 250 words long. Entries will not be returned.
4. Templates are enclosed for ease of reference. In addition to (3) above, applicants will be required to submit the template as an example of their design, as part of their entry submission. Frames cannot be altered. The design must fit within the configuration.
5. All entries must be received by **25th September 2020**.
6. All entries must be the original work of the individual and must not have been published or exhibited elsewhere or have won a prize in any other competition. It is the responsibility of each entrant to ensure that their entry does not infringe the intellectual rights of any third party or any laws.
7. Rights in all designs, except in the overall winning design, submitted for this competition remain with the respective entrants. However, as consideration of the Government of Gibraltar providing the competition, each entrant grants a worldwide, irrevocable, perpetual licence to the Government of Gibraltar or their agents to feature any or all of the submitted designs in any of their publications, their websites and / or in any promotional material connected to this competition without payment to the entrant.
8. The overall winner agrees to assign all their intellectual property rights in their original design to The Government of Gibraltar. Should the winner refuse, the Government of Gibraltar reserves the right to disqualify the entry and award this prize to another entrant.
9. Only two entries may be submitted per person. Late, illegible, incomplete, defaced entries or entries not within the design criteria will not be accepted. No responsibility can be accepted for lost entries and proof of transmission will not be accepted as proof of receipt.

10. The decision of the judge(s) is final and no correspondence will be entered into relating to this decision.
11. The winning entrant will have their design turned into a full scale stained glass window by the entity / entities chosen by the Government of Gibraltar or its agents. HMGOG or GCS reserve the right to adapt the final design for the reproduction of the stained glass. The design will be on permanent display at the Central Hall.
12. The winner will be invited to attend the unveiling of the stain glass window. Travel, accommodation or incidental expenses for attending the ceremony are not included.
13. The winner shall be required to take part in any publicity as required by the Government of Gibraltar.
14. The overall winner will receive a prize of £2000.
15. The Government of Gibraltar may at its absolute discretion vary, amend or cancel the competition and the entrant must agree that no liability shall attach to the Government as a result thereof.
16. Entries may be handed in during working hours at Gibraltar Cultural Services, City Hall, Gibraltar or via email as details below.

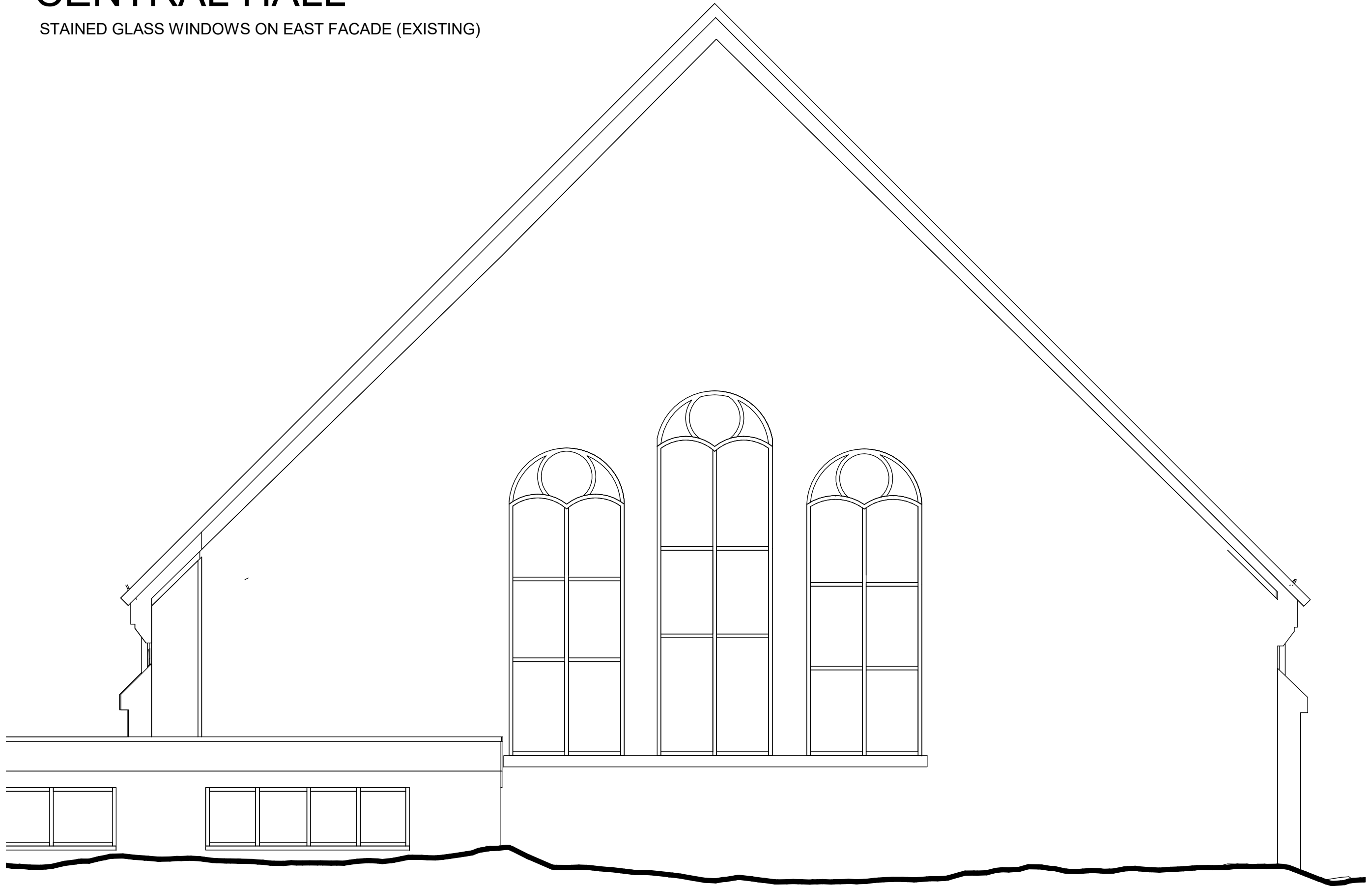
