

Cultural Grants – Standard Conditions

1. Grant must be used only for the purpose for which it has been awarded.
2. Grants may be awarded, in some cases, for part of the application only. This will be explained in the Offer letter.
3. The amount of the grant stated in the offer letter is the maximum payable.
4. The Association/Entity must be registered in the Cultural Associations Register in order for a grant to be awarded.
5. The Association/Entity must use the logo **#VISITGIBALTAR** on any promotional material both printed and online, kit, uniform, etc. that is used for the event. Photographic evidence of this must be submitted. Failure to do so may result in the Grant being cancelled.
6. A breakdown of costs incurred, accompanied by receipts, to cover the whole of the Grant awarded, must be submitted to Gibraltar Cultural Services Ltd as soon as the costs have been paid, and within the same financial year, i.e. before the end of the following March.
7. By accepting the offer, the Association/Entity is agreeing to allow access to any of the financial records relating to the grant.
8. In the event that Association/Entity is not able to comply with the conditions of the grant, or the activity for which the grant was awarded does not take place, the Association/Entity must make immediate arrangements to repay the grant.
9. The Association/Entity is responsible of being fully aware of issues relating to the protection of children and vulnerable adults.
10. The Association/Entity is required to obtain any licenses, permits and insurances as are required.
11. The Association/Entity is responsible for obtaining its own financial and legal advice. This includes obtaining advice on their tax status as a result of receiving a Cultural Grant.
12. The Association/Entity is responsible for the management of its own affairs.
13. HMGoG or its agents will not be held liable for any debts that the Association/Entity may incur, and will not be held responsible for any proceedings that may be instituted against it.
