

## AUTUMN BOOKMARK COMPETITION 2018

### RULES AND CONDITIONS

#### 1. GENERAL

- a) The competition is open to anyone resident in Gibraltar.
- b) Artists may submit two works on the theme 'Famous Dyslexics'.
- c) Entries must be in A4 paper or card.
- d) Works must be original. On signing the entry form the artist confirms that the work is original.
- e) Works are submitted at the artist own risk. It is a condition of the entry submission that the organisers shall not be liable for any loss or damage to any such work, however caused.
- f) An independent adjudicator chosen by Gibraltar Cultural Services (GCS) will judge the competition.
- g) The decision of GCS's CEO on any issue outside the adjudication proper will be final.
- h) Employees of Gibraltar Cultural Services and of the Ministry of Culture, as well as their family members, are allowed to take part in the competition. Subject to it being operationally possible for GCS to keep the participant out of the judging process and for the participant not to have any contact with the adjudicator/judges.

#### 2. ENTRY FORM

- a) The official entry form must be completed in full and signed by the artist (and parent/guardian in the case of those aged under 18) to indicate acceptance of the rules and conditions of entry.
- b) Entry forms and artworks are to be handed in at the **John Mackintosh Hall reception as from Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> September 2018 between 9am and 4pm.** The closing date for entries will be **Friday 12<sup>th</sup> October 2018.**
- c) All work must have the artists name, address and telephone numbers on the reverse of the design.
