2. Any person, organisation or company can nominate anyone for any of the categories, and in more than one on separate forms.

Conditions of Entry

1. Individuals who are people with an approved legal status (citizens, permanent residents, migrants with work permit, international students) who have an established and verifiable record of achievement in one or more fields in Community, Arts & Culture as per specifications contained in each prescribed category are eligible to enter the Gibraltar Cultural Services, Cultural Awards 2019.
2. In addition, the Judges may, at their discretion, recognise and honour individuals for their special achievement and/or contribution to one or more areas that may or may not have been specified.
3. The Judges will consider the achievements of persons nominated or those who have sent their direct entries for the period covering 1st July 2018 to 30th June 2019.
4. Strict confidentiality of the contents of entries will be maintained by the independent Judges, but no liability is accepted for any loss or damage of the forms or related material submitted should this be affected before receipt.
5. Please use Arial font size of no less than 10 point. The word limits in the entry are to be observed. Supplementary information including Certificates, Photographs, paper clippings or any such material may be considered but are not required and may not be taken into account.
6. The Judges will contact the entrants, nominators or nominees in case of need. The decision of the Judges will be final and no correspondence will be entertained in this regard.

APPENDIX 1.

Cultural Awards Categories defined;

Junior Award

An individual or group of artists under 12 years of age that shows potential or has displayed real talent.

Youth Award

An individual or group of artists under 25 years of age that shows potential or has displayed real talent.

Senior Award

An individual or group of artists over 25 years of age that shows potential or has displayed real talent.

Best Education Project

A project that shows the power of art and culture to engage young people and create high-quality artistic outputs.

The Cultural Ambassador Award

An artist or artistic endeavour which has promoted Gibraltar's talent or the Rock as a destination to a wider audience, or helped put the Rock on the map.

Cultural Space of the Year

Dedicated venue or space used / or that has been used for the arts / performance. The award will recognise Gibraltar's history and heritage and unique spaces which may have been used for specific events or exhibitions in a bid to promote our surroundings and environment. It will recognise the group or individual which organised the event, or another cultural activity.
