Rules and Conditions

1. The Competition is open to persons of all ages who may submit a maximum of two logos.
2. Only original works may be submitted.
3. **Each entry should be submitted on ONE A4 paper or card. The entrants name must be written on the reverse (it MUST NOT appear on the front). Entries should be attached to the entry form with a paper clip, not stapled.**
4. Logos should be simple in design and suitable for printing on posters, flyers, tickets or other promotional material and must contain the wording:

'GIBRALTAR SPRING FESTIVAL 2020'

5. Entries are submitted at the participant's own risk. The Ministry of Culture will not be liable for any loss or damage to any entry.
6. All entries will become the property of the Ministry of Culture and no work will be returned.
7. The winning entry becomes the property of the Ministry of Culture. The Ministry of Culture will own the copyright and may use all or part of the logo, at any time subsequently.
8. A panel will judge the competition. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
9. The prize for the winning entry is £500.
10. The Ministry of Culture reserves the right to NOT use the winning logo.
11. The Ministry of Culture reserves the right to cancel this competition at any stage if deemed necessary in its opinion and if circumstances arise outside its control.
12. The information in the entry form is kept and used only strictly in line with the Data Protection Act 2004.
13. Works may be handed in during working hours at the John Mackintosh Hall, 308 Main Street.
14. Employees of Gibraltar Cultural Services and of the Ministry of Culture, as well as their family members, are allowed to take part in the competition. Subject to it being operationally possible for GCS to keep the participant out of the judging process and for the participant not to have any contact with the adjudicator/judges.
